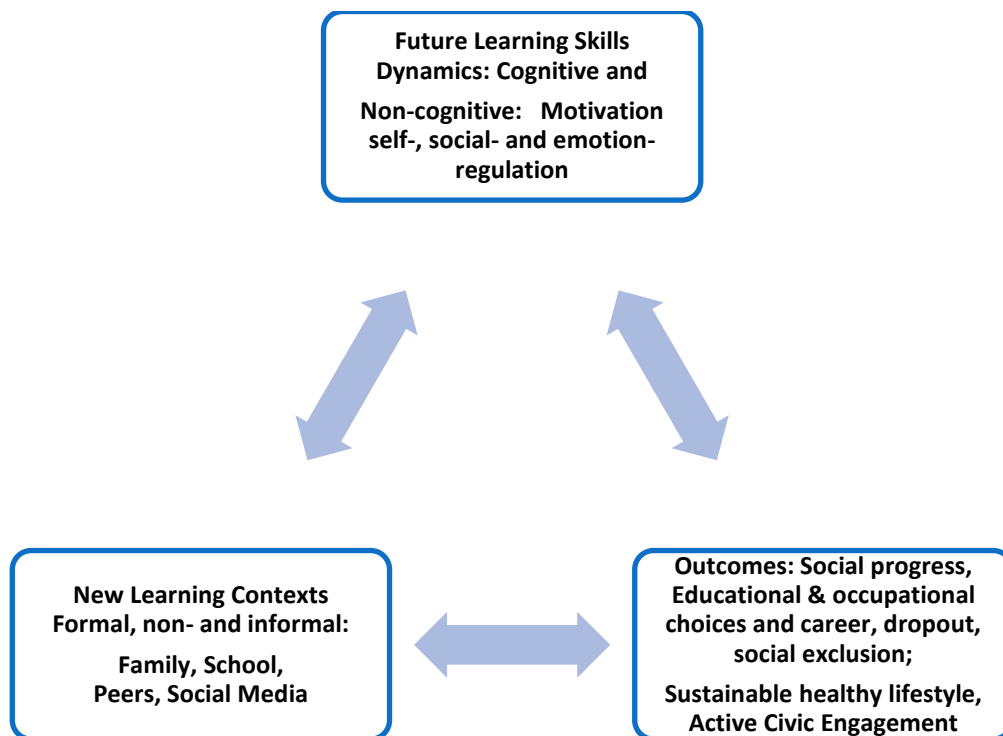


LEAD – Future Learning Skills: A longitudinal Study of Development in a Global Context

1- Short Description

LEAD project (see model) integrates longitudinal, process-oriented, comparative and natural experiment to examine the developmental dynamics of future learning skills, identify their determinants and consequences in a global context. LEAD project is based on life-course contextual-developmental model of engagement (Salmela-Aro, 2013).

Objectives: 1. Future learning skill development, and their short and long-term outcomes to educational and occupational careers, sustainable healthy lifestyles and civic engagement. 2. The role of learning contexts of school, peers and family that drive learning skill development? 3. Daily dynamics- What engages different learning groups? 4. Future learning skill development in global context. 5 The role of Finnish school reform for skill development.
